**55/20. Apologies for absence.**

There were none.

**56/20. Declaration of Interest** (Members are requested to declare any interest they may have in the business set out on the Agenda to which the approved Code of Practice appears.)

Cllr Richard Williams declared an interest in Agenda Item 57/20 with regards to any proposals for restrictions in The Street.

Cllr John Phillips declared an interest in Agenda Item 57/20 with regards to any proposals for restrictions by the Church.

**57/20. To consider a response to the proposals for the parking Traffic Regulation Order, before it goes out for formal consultation.**

Prior to the meeting the Members had been sent out proposals from Highways to consider. The Clerk suggested that they seek feedback from residents prior to sending back a response. Various views were then forwarded to the Clerk, many showing concern for some of the proposals put forward.

The Chairman, Cllr Richard Williams suggested that the Members go through each of the proposals and try to agree a way forward. Then after this meeting consider what has been suggested and agree a formal response at the September meeting.

*Clerks Note: the recommendations that follow may change and will not be put forward as a formal response until after the September Parish Council meeting.*

**a. Church Road (from outside the gate of Church House) to the junction of The Street.**

Recommend: 2 hour parking restriction to be applied from 8am – 6pm .

(Note the bays by the school and church to be excluded).

**b. Cemetery Road**

Recommend: double yellow lines are installed where the road is narrow and a 2 hour parking restriction on the rest of the road to be applied from 8am – 6pm.

**c. Coln Road**

Recommend: double yellow lines are installed from the junction to approximately 20 metres past the where the footpath leading from Aldsworth meets the Coln Road.

**d. The Street**

Recommend:

- In the parking bays - that a 2 hour parking restriction to be applied from 8am to 6pm.
- That no loading is permitted along The Street.

**e. The parking bays opposite the Trout Farm**

Recommend: 2 hour parking restriction to be applied from 8am to 6pm.

**f. Outside Arlington Mill**

Recommend: that two disabled parking bays be installed.
