Bins - The new wooden bins have been delivered and they should be installed soon. (Arlington Fields, Batt Field and entrance to Arlington Row).

Noticeboard (Arlington Green) – this is out for repair, unfortunately it will be with the workshop for a while as they have a backlog of work to complete.

Play Equipment – monitoring and repairs will be carried out as per the Rospa report plus spikes added to the Swing basket frame.

Gloucestershire County Council – have launched an initiative to improve the safety of country roads. The “Community Speedwatch Safety Fund” aims to make the county’s roads safer for the pedestrians, cyclists and motorists that use them. Applications can be submitted for a range of measures, including Road Safety Officer support, speed surveys, ‘Twenty is Plenty’ wheelie bin stickers, vehicle activated signs to encourage drivers to slow down, and community speedwatch cameras.
